## Minutes of Meeting of Board of Directors of Deerfield Village Property Owners' Association, Inc.

A meeting of the Board of Directors of Deerfield Village Property Owners' Association, Inc. was held at 7:00 PM on May 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2023 at 21 Blossom View Court, Deerfield Village, Shepherdstown, WV. Bill Sturtevant reported prior to the meeting to Mike Vaeth that 39 trees had been planted for the Spring planting by 17 volunteers. The next planting goal is this Fall.

The July meeting which would fall on the 4<sup>th</sup> will most likely be changed next month. The next regular meeting on June 6<sup>th</sup> will be at the home of Paul Wilmoth. Kirk announced that his family's fireworks display is planned for Saturday, July 1st.
